Education can change the life of a child living on the street. Sharmi escaped a difficult situation when she was 10 and was adopted into a family. This changed her life by giving her the hope of Jesus and the opportunity for an education. Today, Sharmi is 28 years old and has a Master's degree in Education. Because of the impact of love and education had in her life, she wants to pass that on to others. She is now the principal of Nirmal School, which provides education to street kids. You can help change the life of a child by supporting their education at Nirmal School in Kathmandu, Nepal. It costs \$40 per month to send a child to school in Nepal. Together, our goal is to send two children to school for a year.

2ND + 3RD GRADE



Jesus came bringing Living Water, which gives peace to all. Titus Luther lives in the Solomon Islands. He is bringing Jesus and clean water to people who have only known war. Clean water can transform the health of a community. We have partnered with Titus Luther in the Solomon Islands. We help to provide water filters to meet the physical needs of a community in the midst of unrest. Titus Luther has built a place of peace that unites people who were once at war with one another. You can help provide clean water for people learning to live at peace with one another in the Solomon Islands by purchasing water filters that can serve 40 people each. Each water filter costs \$50. Together our goal is to purchase 5 water filters to service 200 people.

if everyone brought \$5, we could meet our goal

- Choose to drink only water for a day. Give the money that would have been spent on juice, hot chocolate, milk, etc.
- Are there extra chores around the house or a family member's house that you could do?
- Collect cans and bottles.

- Choose to pack a lunch instead of eating a meal out or paying for school lunch.
- Instead of buying a gift for someone, consider making them a gift instead (or giving a skill). Give the money that would have been spent on that gift.

In Guatemala, we partner with Medical Missions Ministry. This ministry has allowed us to meet many amazing people who love the Lord and serve Him with great joy. One of those people is Pastor Lester. He serves 115 children breakfast every day before school. Joy fills his house each morning as a team prepares the meal and the children enjoy breakfast together. Together, we can help spread the joy of the Lord in Guatemala. We can help feed a community of children breakfast before school. It costs \$10 per month to feed one child breakfast. Together our goal is to purchase breakfast for 5 children for a year.



- Designate a "no spend day" and keep track of the money you would have spent that day to give.
- Pack a meal instead of eating out or paying for a school lunch. (Bonus: see if your family wants to join you!)
- Collect cans and bottles.

- Do you get an allowance? Consider giving your allowance or doing extra chores around the house.
- Think about your skills (baking, card or jewelry making, etc.).
