BASIC TRUTH

I need to make the wise choice.



1. TELL THE TRUTH

[LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED/IN YOUR LAUNCH BOX: "Tell the Truth Gameboard" and "Tell the Truth Scenarios" (Activity Pages), spinner or spinner app, tokens

WHAT YOU DO:

- Game can be played with two or three (if there are more than 3, break up into teams of 2 or 3).
- Set the "Tell the Truth Gameboard" on the floor and have everyone gather around it.
- Give each player a token to place at START
- Each player takes a turn, spinning the spinner and placing their token on the nearest space that matches the color they spun.
- If the token lands on a space with "Tell the Truth!", read a scenario from "Tell the Truth Scenarios" and guide the player to answer. (They may ask for help; it's okay to work together to answer.)
- If they answer correctly, lead them to move their token forward two spaces.
- If they answer incorrectly, guide them to go back one space.
- Continue play until every player reaches FINISH.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"God wants you to tell the truth, because **when you're not truthful, you lose trust**. But when you ARE truthful, you gain trust! You gain God's trust, and you gain people's trust. So, tell the truth and do what you say you're going to do. Be a person of integrity so that people will know they can trust you! Because **when you're not truthful, you lose trust.**"



What to Do:

Print on cardstock and tape together. Provide one for each small group.

You call your sister a name. When she tells your mom, do you:

Say, "NO, I didn't!" or

Tell the truth and say you're sorry?

It's your mom's birthday, and she loves flowers. Do you:

Pick some flowers from the park, or

Draw some flowers for her instead?

It's time to do your chores, but you decide to play a video game instead. When your mom sees you playing, do you say:

"Oh, I forgot!" or

"I'm sorry."

You break something at school. When your teacher asks what happened, do you say,

"I don't know," or

"I'm sorry. It was my fault."

You get mad at your friend and push him. Do you:

Say it was an accident, or

Tell him the truth and say you're sorry.

You get to school and realize that you forgot to do your homework. Do you:

Tell your teacher that your mom forgot to put it in your backpack, or

Say, "I'm sorry. I forgot to do it."

You copy your friend's paper to finish a math problem. When your teacher asks you if you copied, do you say:

"Yes. I'm sorry," or

"No, I didn't."
