### MEMORY VERSE

"God is with you wherever you go." JOSHUA 1:9, NLT

### **KEY QUESTION**

Who's got it?

### **BOTTOM LINE**

God's got it.

### **BASIC TRUTH**

God loves me.

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** Walk around the room with your child, looking for the water bottle. Pretend to be hot and thirsty as you walk; make it dramatic.


AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how in our Bible story we'll hear about a woman and her son who were hot and thirsty in the desert.

### WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Today, we're going to play a game of hide and seek. We'll be the seekers looking for the hidden battle of water."

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** "Let's start walking. Do you see any water, yet? (Walk around the room then start the actual search.) I don't either. Oh, I'm getting tired and thirsty. Where could that water be? Let's keep walking. Show me your tired, thirsty faces. (Pause.) Let's try to find the water. Where should we look?

(Pause.) No water here. I'm soooo thirsty. Where should we look next? (Pause.) Did we find it? (Pause.) But I'm so thirsty! I guess we should keep looking. (Keep walking and looking.) Are we there yet? Yay! We found the water! (Pause.) I'm so tired. Let's sit down. Show me your happy faces. (Pause.) Great job!"

# IN THE RAIN

WHAT YOU NEED: "Umbrella Verse" Activity Page on cardstock, blue finger paint in a portion cup and wet wipes

WHAT IS IN THE LAUNCH BOX: "Umbrella Verse" Activity Page on cardstock and blue finger paint in a portion cup

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** Encourage your child to make raindrops on their paper with their fingers using the finger paint.

**AFTER THE ACTIVITY:** Say the memory verse together.

### WHAT YOU SAY:

**BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:** "When do you use an umbrella? (*Pause.*) Most of the times you use an umbrella when it's raining. Sometimes you use it when it's sunny outside. God is with you when it's sunny or raining, God is with you wherever you go."

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** "God is with you wherever you go. That's our Memory Verse, and it's written on the umbrella on your paper. Let's add some raindrops on your paper with your fingerprints and finger paint.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Let's say our memory verse together. God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9. Great! One more time: God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9. No matter where you go, God's got it. Who's got it? God's got it."
