DAY 1

ACTS 9: 13-16

- 1 Rephrase Ananias' response to God's request in your own words.
- 2 What are people or groups today that are thought of as being 'beyond redemption' by the church?
- 3 Are there people or groups that you view as beyond God's reach?

LIVE IT OUT

What's one thing you can do this week to be more graceful to people/groups you consider beyond redemption?

DAY 2

ACTS 9:17-25

- 1 What were the different responses to Saul's conversion?
- 2 Can you think of someone you who has had a complete 180 in their life? How did people respond to this?
- 3 Have you ever done a 180 in your life? How did people respond to you when you did?

LIVE IT OUT

Ask that God would give you the courage to make any changes in your life, big or small, that need to happen.

DAY 3

ACTS 9:26-39

- 1 What did Saul's introduction to the apostles in Jerusalem look like?
- 2 Do you know an advocate for others like Barnabas was for Saul? Describe them.
- 3 Have you advocated for someone like Barnabas did? What would it look like for you to be an advocate for someone?

LIVE IT OUT

What's one way that you can advocate for someone this week?

DAY 4

ACTS 9:30-31

- 1 What happened after Saul went back to Tarsus and what was the state of the church?
- 2 What does the state of the church throughout Acts tell you about seasons in the church today?
- 3 At the end of this chapter, we find the church at peace, does this challenge or encourage you? Why?

LIVE IT OUT

Thank God for the seasons of peace and write down some of the specific things you are grateful for.

DAY 5

ACTS 9:32-43

- 1 What result did both of these miracles performed by Peter have?
- 2 What things that happen today have a similar result?
- 3 What things have you seen or has gone done in your life that lead you to believe in him?

LIVE IT OUT

Spend some time thanking God for the many ways he works in our world and in our lives.
